5/20	<b>Application: 2/2020/0824/HOUSE</b> <b>Proposal:</b> Erect tree house <b>Location:</b> Sundial House, Weston Street, Buckhorn Weston, SP8 5HG The applicant was interested to hear the Parish Council’s comments regarding his application. He confirmed that the tree house will be set to the rear of the garden and among the trees so it blends in with them, is unseen from the road and will be constructed from natural and reclaimed materials. The tree officer has requested a tree survey which is in hand. The applicant considered the height of the tree house will have very little impact on neighbouring properties and confirmed no objections have been received. The applicant was advised that discussing proposals with neighbours is good practise and helps the process. The councillors considered the proposal to be straightforward. Cllr Mrs Munster proposed the “Parish Council support the application as it does not appear to encroach on the privacy of the neighbours and the proposed design and materials are sympathetic to the structure’s purpose”.
