This has been addressed in a supporting statement by legal council which stipulates in point 8(iii) that a covenant would restrict the converted dwelling by having 'the effect of being an extension of the existing residential accommodation on the farm rather than the provision of a separate open market dwelling' and 'no opportunity for anybody to purchase or lease the converted barn as an independent residential unit' therefore the Parish Council were satisfied with the current application. Cllr Ms Chapman proposed "the Parish Council support this application as there are no issues regarding highways safety and the materials intended are in keeping with the existing building and the surrounding area."
