04/24	<b>Application:</b> P/FUL/2024/01713 <b>Proposal:</b> Erection of general purpose agricultural building <b>Location:</b> Barton Elm, Barton Hill, Kington Magna, SP8 5EH It was noted that planning is required due to being within 3 miles of the airfield. The applicant confirmed the new barn will be used mainly as a store for livestock feed and, being positioned behind the existing barn, will cut down on current fuel costs and aid their expanding business. It was noted the new structure will be slightly higher than the existing. The applicant advised their future intention is to add a lean to which will mean the additional height allows for a run off. The proposed materials are a cement fibre roof, galvanised steel, green sheets and Yorkshire boarding. The aim is to hide the barn as much as possible by installing a bank around the structure, take out dead elms and vegetation and plant new native hedging. The entrance will remain the same. No objections have been raised. Cllr Ms Chapman proposed "the Parish Council support this application as it will assist the applicant with the growth of their business and the materials proposed are similar to the existing structure and appropriate for agricultural use."
